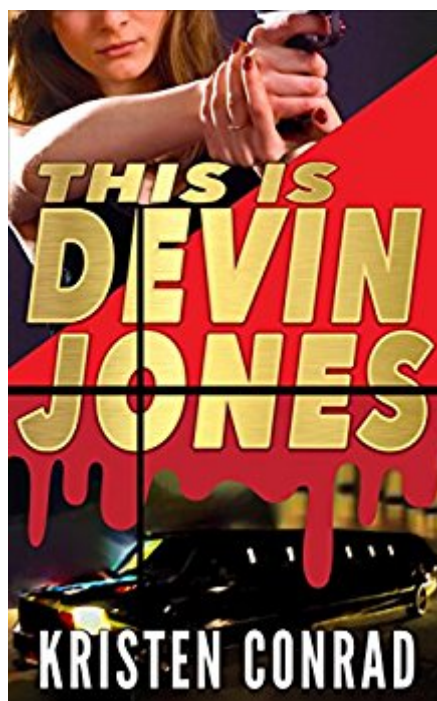

Okay, this story was decent. Had it's funny moments and it's gory moments. Believable? Not so much. Also, I think the author could have taken ten or fifteen minutes out to do some research on the one type of gun she had being used in this story. A Glock. Okay, I understand why she used a Glock as that's a very common, well-known gun. Used by law enforcement personnel across the US. However, there is no Glock 9. There IS a Glock 19. Glock's do NOT have a manual safety and yet multiple times she had Devin 'release the safety'. Glock magazines could have ended there. Adding the word 'clips' afterwards was redundant and most gun people go a little crazy when the word 'clip' is used instead of magazine. LOL Oh, and there is NO hammer on a Glock. Just multiple things - would actually probably be easier if the author would do a seek and replace for Glock to any other of the hundreds of guns available to use that does have a safety (of course that doesn't mean all of these have a hammer), any 1911, FN9 (can get with or without a safety so that would work), Beretta 92, Beretta M9 (would be even better could just change Glock to Beretta and put an "M" in front of the 9) etc... etc... There are so many guns that could have used that would work for what she wanted but going with Glock because of it's name and not following through on the characteristics of a Glock is kind of a cop out.
