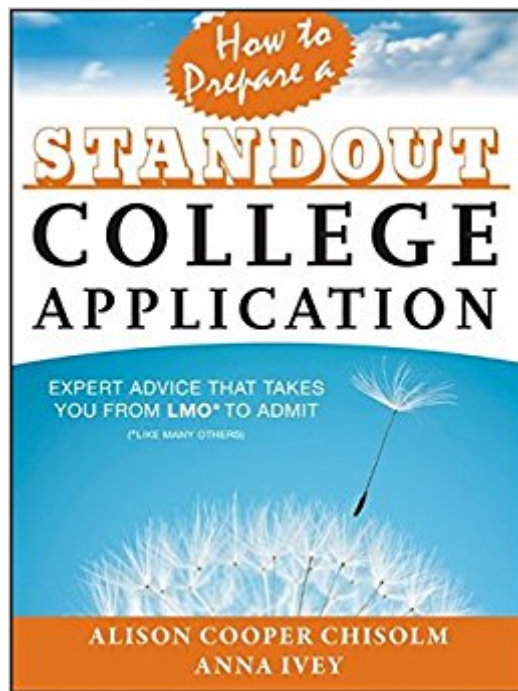

I've probably read nearly a dozen books on the college admissions process and this is a must-have book for any student applying to a competitive college or any student applying to a "reach" college (one that is tough to get into given the student's high school record). In lieu of reading this book, you could hire a college admissions consultant for thousands of dollars. In fact, the authors of this book are admissions consultants. There is nothing in this 350 page book that was a waste of time as

crafting an excellent application takes 350 pages worth of knowledge. Surprise! This book is excellent in every way. It is interesting and complete. The advice is accurate and based on extensive experience. The other day, I ran into a student who was rejected by Stanford. I asked him which college admissions books he had read and he replied, "none." I'm fairly certain that most students who are admitted to Stanford would not have the same reply. It's a shame that a student who outperforms everyone else in his high school omits this one necessary step in the college admissions process and suffers the consequences. In fact, the higher the college goals, the more books one should read and the earlier one should start reading. One of the biggest mistakes I see is that quality students and those around them don't understand the college admissions process for selective colleges.
