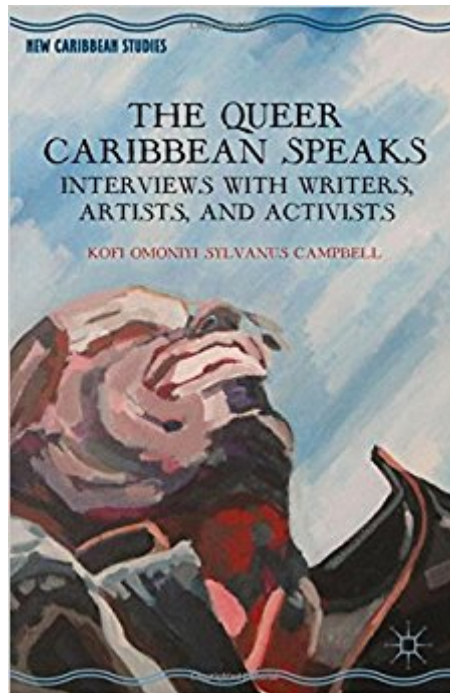


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# The Queer Caribbean Speaks: Interviews With Writers, Artists, And Activists (New Caribbean Studies)
